


Most Americans continue to believe race or color affects treatment by society

%Affected a great deal or good amount






Most Americans think the country has made progress on equal treatment

In the future, do you think the U.S. will be a place where people are treated equally regardless of their race or skin color, or not?






Over past five decades, growing support for integration

% who think more should be done. All Americans.







Most Americans support ending affirmative action in schools



Percent who think the following is a good thing or a bad thing for companies to adopt... Fielded February 2025


Percent who think companies adopting diversity, equity and inclusion programs are a good thing 2024-2025

Closing all federal government "DEI" offices and firing all federal employees working in "DEI"


Abolishing diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) offices and programs in the Defense Department and the Department of Homeland Security

Do you support or oppose workplaces having each of the following programs




