

- First line beneficiaries are mostly NGOs (with thousands of volunteers helping the project)

- Currently endorsed by FAO and UNEP and the EU Directorate- General for Health and Food Safety
- Part of the FORCE consortium "cities cooperating for a circular economy" in food and biowaste
- An infrastructure/platform prepared to be scaled to any type of waste (textile, plastic, electronics, etc...) presenting the main impact indicators in real time and tracking potential waste in any part of the chain
- Potential development of a blockchain platform able to end-to-end back track any type of waste



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


Resulting from the process of composting organic matter from biodegradable waste (food waste and green waste), the production of organic fertilizer for use in organic farming



Outcomes to date: Process Composting Capacity (60.000 tons /year): 15.000 tons organic fertilizer/year
