Dates: June 7–9, 2026

Day 1 – June 7, 2026 | Istanbul – İzmir City Tour

At 06:00 in the morning, guests will be picked up from **Hilton Istanbul Bomonti Hotel & Conference Center** and transferred to Istanbul Airport.

At 09:00, departure from Istanbul with a Pegasus Airlines flight, arriving in İzmir at 10:10.

Upon arrival, the group will be transferred to the city center and the İzmir city tour will begin. The program includes:

- Visit to İzmir Agora (Historical Agora)
- Walking tour in Kemeraltı Bazaar
- Visit to Kızlarağası Inn

Throughout the tour, our professional guide will provide detailed information about İzmir's historical and cultural heritage.

Guests will have free time for lunch, with the opportunity to try local street food based on the guide's recommendations.

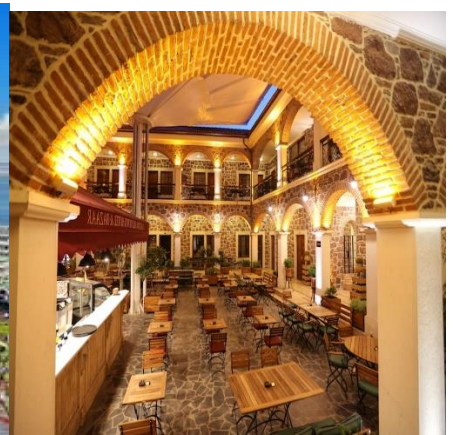
After lunch, the tour will continue with:

Day 2 – June 8, 2026 | İzmir – Ephesus- House of the Virgin Mary-Sirince Village

After breakfast at the hotel, the group will depart for Ephesus.

- Ephesus Experience Museum
- The Temple of Artemis (Artemision)

Following the guided tour, lunch will be served at a local restaurant.

- Şirince Village

At the end of the tour, the group will return to İzmir.

Upon arrival at the hotel, guests will have free time to relax. In the evening, dinner will be served at a local restaurant, followed by a return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 3 – June 9, 2026 | İzmir – Sığacık – Urla – Istanbul

After breakfast at the hotel, guests will complete the check-out process, and we will load our luggage onto the vehicle before heading to Sığacık, one of İzmir's charming coastal towns in **Seferihisar**.

Sığacık is one of the most important seaside towns in the Aegean Region. The market established within the historic castle walls, at the heart of **Sığacık**, is not only a shopping spot but also a strong representation of

women's entrepreneurship. Homemade jams, tarhana, olive oil dishes, and handicrafts prepared by local women offer visitors a natural and sincere experience. While supporting local production, this market also keeps **Sığacık's** cultural heritage alive. As you stroll through the narrow streets filled with stalls, you can feel the story and effort behind each product. During the free time in the area, you may enjoy coffee, shop, and experience the essence of Aegean Turkish culture.

After this visit, we will continue to another important destination and head towards **Urla**. Reflecting the elegant spirit of the Aegean, Urla stands out with its deep-rooted gastronomy culture, especially its olive oil and wine production. Aromatic olive oils obtained from olives grown in the region's fertile lands form the foundation of Urla cuisine, while boutique wines made from local grapes give the town a unique culinary identity. Vineyards and olive groves along scenic routes offer visitors an unforgettable experience intertwined with nature and taste. Urla is one of the most special stops in the Aegean, where tradition and modern production are harmoniously blended.

Our first stop in **Urla** will be at the pier, where we will take a coastal walk while listening to our guide's insights. Then we will visit **Urla Art Street** and stroll through streets that reflect the cultural richness of this charming town.

After a pleasant day, we will proceed to İzmir Airport and complete our check-in procedures.
At 19:40, departure to Istanbul with a Pegasus Airlines flight.
Arrival in Istanbul at 20:55, marking the end of our tour.
